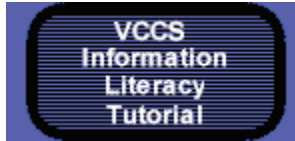

What is “CONNECT For Success”?

An online information literacy tutorial



Why should I spend time on it?

To develop fundamental knowledge and skills needed to find, evaluate and cite good information, and to prepare for the Information Literacy Competency Assessment given to degree graduates in certain years

What exactly is the Information Literacy Competency Assessment?

A 54-question test given to all prospective ESCC degree graduates in certain years (scores reported to ESCC and VCCS)

Who can use “CONNECT For Success”?

ESCC students and staff

Where can I access it?

In the LRC, in an open lab or from any off-campus location

What is the Web address?
