

**EASTERN SHORE COMMUNITY COLLEGE  
MATH FACULTY POSITION (#F0015)**

**Type of Appointment:**

Nine month full-time appointment beginning August 16, 2008. Faculty appointments are usually at the rank of instructor or assistant professor; rank and salary are commensurate with experience and qualifications.

**Qualifications:**

**Required:** Master's degree in mathematics or Master's degree with at least 18 graduate semester hours in mathematics.

**Preferred:** Community college teaching experience; experience teaching developmental math; experience in developmental math program development; experience teaching precalculus, calculus and statistics; experience teaching online.

**Position Responsibilities:**

Primary emphasis is on teaching developmental math; possible teaching of advanced math. Teaching schedule includes fall and spring semesters teaching on average 15 credit hours per semester. Office hours, advising and other related duties are required. Teaching schedules typically include both day and evening assignments and may include off campus locations. Opportunities for summer teaching will be based on college needs.
