ESCC Course Delivery Modalities


- 1. ON CAMPUS traditional, on campus; room location is available in the schedule of classes
- **2. Zoom VIRTUAL** <u>100% online via required Zoom sessions during scheduled days and times</u> (synchronous)
- 3. VIRTUAL 100% online any time; no scheduled meeting days and times (asynchronous)
- **4. HYBRID** combination of any of the above

Important: Log into MyESCC (your student portal), click on CANVAS, click on and view each of your classes to locate important course information including assignments and deadlines.

1. ON CAMPUS:


In this example, there are days, times and a classroom number indicating this is an on-campus class:



When viewing a class such as the one above, click on it to read a detailed description of how the course is delivered in the **NOTES** section. The note here says "all on campus with no Zoom option".



2. Zoom - VIRTUAL - REQUIRED ZOOM CLASS SESSIONS DURING SCHEDULED DAYS AND TIMES



When clicking on the class and viewing the NOTES section, it is described as:


Zoom online; class meets online during the scheduled days and times using Zoom conferencing software.

3. VIRTUAL – NOT ON CAMPUS, NO SCHEDULED ZOOM SESSIONS:

100% online classes appear with odd days and times such as Sundays at 1:07 AM. For these classes, students work remotely and independently with course materials and do not attend class on campus or via Zoom during any scheduled days and times.

When clicking on a class and viewing the NOTES section, it describes it as:

Anytime Online; delivered online without any required Zoom meetings; students have firm deadlines for tests and assignments; students have live access to an instructor each week through Zoom, phone, chat or email.



4. HYBRID:

Some classes may be delivered in a combination of any of the above. Reading the full description and notes for all classes will explain this. Additionally, here is an example of a class in which the <u>lecture</u> is 100% online anytime and the <u>lab</u> is held via Zoom. Note that some instructors may make Zoom sessions available for later viewing. Details will be shared by the instructors.
