

FAQs Registered Nursing Program

1. **What are the requirements to apply to the program?**
 - a. BIO 141, ENG 111, PSY 230, MTH 154/155, and SDV 101. All other courses are co-requisites. BIO 142, BIO 150, PHI 220 are co-requisites.
2. **If I've taken a higher-level math, will it satisfy the MTH 154/155 requirement?**
 - a. Yes. Please make sure if a math course was taken at a different institution, it transfers.
3. **Do I have to submit my high school transcript if I already have a degree?**
 - a. All students are required to submit their high school transcript with their application.
4. **If I have a foreign transcript from high school, what do I do?**
 - a. If you completed high school or college outside of the United States, you must have these transcripts evaluated by a professional organization or an agency that is a member of the National Association of Credential Evaluators, or is approved by the Department of Education to confirm the completion of an approved four-year high school course of study equivalence. The fee for this evaluation and the time required for completion of the evaluation varies with each agency, and is the responsibility of the student.  - b. Instruct the evaluating agency to mail the official high school transcript evaluation report to you in a sealed envelope. For college transcript evaluation reports, request one official copy to be ailed directly to the Office of the College Registrar and one official copy to be mailed to you in a sealed envelope. **Do not open the sealed envelope(s)**. The official high school and/or college transcript evaluation report(s) sent to you will need to be submitted in your complete nursing application packet to the Beazley School of Nursing.
 - c. **For applicants who are unable or unwilling to provide this translated and certified documentation, an official General Education Development (GED) certificate will satisfy the high school equivalency requirement.**
5. **Will the Nursing department have access to my transcripts I submitted to Enrollment Services or the College Registrar?**
 - a. The Nursing department **does not** have access to another department's documentation. You must submit official college transcript(s) with your application.
6. **Can I have my transcripts sent electronically?**
 - a. If the institution is **only** utilizing this method, please have the institution send them directly to nursing@tcc.edu.
7. **I took SDV 100 instead of 101. Will this be accepted?**
 - a. The Nursing department will accept SDV 100 if it has already been taken.

8. Is PSY 201/200 a co-requisite requirement?

- a. PSY 201/200 is no longer a co-requisite requirement.

9. Will the admissions committee review recommendation letters, award, or experience?

- a. The admissions committee strictly reviews the pre- and co-requisite requirements. Other documentation will be discarded

10. Who do I send my official college transcript(s) to?

- a. Official college transcripts should be mailed to the applicant's home and submitted with their nursing application. Do not open them. **A second separate set should be mailed to the College Registrar for evaluation.**

11. The College of Registrar stated the course for evaluation process takes up to 12 weeks.

Will this affect my application?

- a. The College Registrar will begin processing transfer evaluations once students are admitted into the program and begin Nursing (NSG) courses. Students may utilize the Transfer Evaluation System (TES) to verify transfer credits.

12. What is the average score for the HESI?

- a. The committee uses the 45th percentile (calculated minimum score to be considered for the program) for eligibility. This could increase or decrease from the previous cycle. Each application cycle is different. You must meet the 45th percentile requirement to be deemed eligible and considered for admission.
