## Undergraduate Scholarships Open to Eastern Shore Students:

AAA Tidewater – J. Theron "Tim" Timmons Scholarship – For students with at least a 3.0 GPA whose parents/ guardians are members of AAA Tidewater. A valid, active membership number is required.

**Jesse T. Bonney Memorial Scholarship** – For female Virginia residents under the age of 26. Preference will be given to students from South Hampton Roads.

Julia Atwater Bristow Scholarship – For students graduating from public high schools in Norfolk and on the Eastern Shore of Virginia. Students must attend a secular college. Students attending religious-affiliated colleges are not eligible.

**Charles F. Burroughs Scholarship** – For students attending Hampden-Sydney College.

**S & C Gagliardi Scholarship** –For graduating high school seniors from public high schools in Accomack County, VA, for full-time attendance at a four-year college or university.

Holland Family Scholarship – For students from the Eastern Shore of Virginia or graduating from Pocomoke High School and Holly Grove Christian School on the Eastern Shore of Maryland who are in need of financial aid for undergraduate education, with a preference for those pursuing degrees related to farming and agriculture.

**Sierra Jenkins Scholarship** – For long-time Virginia residents pursuing a degree in journalism or a degree in communications with a concentration in journalism at a four-year Virginia college or university. Applicants must be studying print or online/digital journalism. Preference will be given to BIPOC students. This is a one-year scholarship; it will not be renewed.

**The Pender Scholarship** – For female students attending Notre Dame of Maryland University in Baltimore.

Students must demonstrate financial need, be long-time residents of South Hampton Roads or the specific localities designated in the criteria, and enroll full-time at a nonprofit college or university in the U.S. that participates in the federal student aid programs.

The application will be available online beginning December 1 and must be submitted on or before March 1.

Complete one application to be considered for all HRCF scholarships for which you are eligible.
