Dr. Shaeffer congratulates him, shakes hands, and presents a challenge coin. Jackson Thierfeldt returns to seat and Dr. Shaeffer remains at the podium to present ESCC highlights.

Dr. Shaeffer, still at podium introduces the COMMENCEMENT SPEAKER, Judge Jamar Walker

Commencement Address: Judge Jamar Walker

Dr. Shaeffer goes to the podium when the speaker has finished, thanks him and presents him with a gift

Dr. Shaeffer remains at the podium and Jamar returns to his seat.

Presentation of Candidates and Awarding of Diplomas

- Dr. Shaeffer is already at the podium and invites Dr. Walter to the podium
- Dr. Shaeffer returns to his seat
- Dr. Walter delivers a short address and when finished, he returns to his seat

Dr. Shaeffer returns to the podium and confers the degrees on all graduates. He instructs the graduates to move their tassel from the right side to the left side of the mortarboard. He asks everyone to congratulate the class of 2024.

Dr. Shaeffer remains at the podium.

Mrs. Duffman goes to the other podium to call out the names of the students as they present their card to her. Eve Belote goes to the diploma table and hands Dr. Shaeffer a diploma cover for the student whose name has been called and is standing in front of him. The student will receive the diploma with the left hand and shake hands with Dr. Shaeffer and exit stage right.

Professional photographer will snap a photo of the student on the stage

NOTE: student will receive a diploma cover, the actual diploma will be picked up at a later date, approximately one week after the ceremony. An email will be sent to you letting you know when they are available. Also, info on how to order your commencement photo will be included in the diploma cover that the student receives.

Student will exit the stage for another photo and return to their seat Once the last student is called, Faculty Senate Chair will return to their seat. Dr. Shaeffer will return to the main podium.

Alumni Association Induction

Dr. Shaeffer recites the induction to the association. Students will be asked to reply, "WE WILL." Dr. Shaeffer formally welcomes the graduates as official members of the ESCC Alumni Association as the Class of 2024!

Dr. Shaeffer returns to his seat and Dr. Walter returns to the podium.

Dr. Walter thanks everyone and introduces Rev. Keith Moody who will give the benediction. All will stand and men remove hats and mortarboards. All guests and graduates will stand during the benediction and remain standing for the Recessional.

Be on Time

You must arrive at the main academic building no later than 4:00 p.m. to put on your cap and gown, receive your name card, and line up for the procession. If you want a professional photo taken in front of the ESCC backdrop, you should arrive by 3:00 p.m. Guests should arrive by 4:30 p.m.
