Transfer Virginia is an innovative resource that can help you navigate the next step in your educational journey.

### TRANSFER VIRGINIA PORTAL

The Transfer Virginia Portal provides a wide range of information about transferring, in an accessible and navigable way.

### PASSPORT

The Passport is a transferable package of five community college courses that fulfills 16 credits towards general education for all public 4-year colleges and most private 4-year colleges in Virginia.

### UNIFORM CERTIFICATE OF GENERAL STUDIES (UCGS)

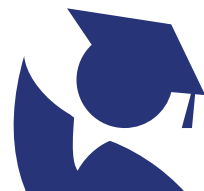
UCGS is a transferable package of 10 community college courses that fulfills 31-32 credits towards general education at all public 4-year colleges and most private 4-year colleges in Virginia.

### TRANSFER GUIDES

Transfer guides provide recommendations on what courses you should take at your local community college to ensure a seamless transfer pathway from an associate degree to a bachelor's degree in different majors at public and private four-year colleges throughout Virginia.

### GUARANTEED ADMISSION AGREEMENTS

Guaranteed Admission Agreements ensure admission to students from Virginia's community colleges and Richard Bland College to most public and private 4-year colleges in Virginia, when eligibility criteria are met. These are applicable to select majors and vary from college to college. Guaranteed Program Admission Agreements are also available in some competitive majors, including engineering, education, and business.





## How does the Transfer Virginia Portal work?

The Transfer Virginia portal is a comprehensive, interactive website that allows you to discover programs, majors, and opportunities at over 60 Virginia colleges. The information in the portal helps to ensure the community college credits you earn transfer to a bachelor's degree program at the college from which you plan to graduate.

### What will you find on the portal?

- Transfer guides
- Guaranteed admission agreements
- Passport and UCGS course details
- College and university profiles, including size and location, academic information, application and financial aid links and deadlines, campus services, and more
- Program and major lists and course descriptions
- Credit calculators, which help you see how courses, exams, and credentials transfer as college credits
- A tool that helps you find transfer programs at other colleges based on your current major
- The ability to search for programs that are available fully online, fully in-person, or a hybrid of the two
- Ways to explore careers based on interests, find careers based on degree, and build a resume

## Getting Started

- 1. Create an account.**  
*Visit [transfervirginia.org/user/register](https://transfervirginia.org/user/register) to begin the process of creating an account.*
- 2. Tell us about yourself.**  
*Go to "My Story" in the portal and share some of your background and relevant experiences and build a portfolio of academic courses, exams, and certificates you've earned.*
- 3. Explore colleges and programs.**  
*Research information about Virginia's colleges and programs to find the right fit.*
- 4. Learn about your college credits, and discover careers related to your degree.**  
*See the anticipated credits that each college will award based on the items in your portfolio when you click "Check My Credits." Dig deeper to see how those credits apply to your major or program of choice.*
- 5. Talk with a transfer advisor.**  
*Through the portal, you can connect with transfer advisors. Ask questions, get answers, and consider what college and program might be right for you.*
- 6. Stay active in the portal.**  
*Continue to use the portal to message with advisors, research colleges and programs, and track your credits. You can even identify future career interests and define your goals and aspirations towards that path.*
