
ELIGIBILITY FOR

VIRGINIA IN-STATE TUITION



In-state tuition is the rate a student pays to attend an institution that is within their state of residence. This rate is often cheaper than the out of state cost. The most common way to receive in-state tuition is by establishing domicile. This means that you can prove that a specific state is your permanent home, in this case, Virginia! Students not able to prove domicile in Virginia can still receive the in-state tuition rate by meeting the requirements of one of the exceptions provided within the Code of Virginia:
